

### WEEKLY WORDS FROM THE ROCK:

LENTEN NORMS OF FASTING AND ABSTAINING: I will keep the norms of fasting and abstaining in my column throughout Lent as a reference point for people seeking the information.

Fasting: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting. The norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 to 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon Catholics from age 14 onwards.

HUH? WHAT? As I mentioned in a weekend homily, Mark's gospel has a sense of urgency to it. Mark doesn't begin his gospel with anything pertaining to the birth or early life of Jesus. He begins with the preaching of John the Baptist and moves into the baptism of Jesus. After Jesus' baptism, we hear in the gospel, "At once the Spirit drove him out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him" (Mark 1:12-13). Our Lenten journey is driven by these two verses. Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert. Lent is a "desert" time. We are to seek the quiet and solace which a desert brings to spend time with our Lord. Our forty-day journey comes from Jesus' forty-day journey in the desert. During these forty days, what can we expect? As the Lord faced temptation, we too will face temptation keeping in mind we are promised the guidance and protection of our guardian angel.

Speaking of temptation, here is a story. When I was in eighth grade, I attended Wednesday evening CCD classes. One Wednesday night, I walked into the classroom and some of my classmates were standing around the teacher's desk eating from a can of peanut brittle. They beckoned me, "Come, Peter, have some peanut brittle." As tempting as it was, I declined. Their temptation took on a higher note of urgency a few minutes later, "Peter, have some peanut brittle!" Enjoying peanut brittle, I decided to have some. After all, what harm was there in it? And that is when things took a turn. As I was standing around the teacher's desk enjoying a treat, the CCD teacher entered the classroom. The remainder of classmates, the "tempters" in this case, scattered and I was left all alone. The teacher gave me a surprised look. Picking up the can of peanut brittle, she asked, "Peter, do you know whose peanut brittle this is?" My response, "No, I don't." She told me, "It belongs to the teacher who teaches in this classroom during the day." I was floored. I had absolutely no idea.

Of my action, there were consequences. I had to do three things:

1. Write a note to the teacher who taught during the day explaining my actions. (Note: Our CCD classes were held in a parochial school. We used the parochial school classrooms for faith formation.)

2. I had to pay for the can of peanut brittle.

3. I had to tell my parents. I told my mother on the way home from class and my father once I arrived home. Not enjoyable!!!

Such is the lesson to be learned. Temptations surround us. If it is too good to be true, it probably is. So be careful and keep your wits about you. The devil is alive and well. Don't play games. Reject temptation and keep your Lenten focus on the Lord.
