WEEKLY WORDS FROM THE ROCK:

Dabbling in the New

Last week, we heard from the tenth chapter of John's gospel. I have noted before that Jesus makes many references to himself in "I am" language.

- I am the true vine
- I am the way, truth, and life.
- I am the bread of life.
- I am the light of the world.
- I am the resurrection and the life.
- I am the door (referring to the sheep).

The tenth chapter of John's gospel also focuses on the "I am" in light of Jesus being the Good Shepherd. When we think about a shepherd, their work entails many things.

- They lead the sheep.
- They keep danger away from their sheep. This is the purpose of a staff.
- They are the conduit of ensuring the safety of their sheep.
- They are the physician of their sheep dealing with cuts and bruises.

The focus of last week's gospel was the sheep recognize the shepherd's voice. This is the natural lead into our gospel of this week. We recognize the voice of Jesus Christ in his words. Here are two examples.

- The Golden Rule Treat others the way you want to be treated.
- The greatest among you is the one who serves the rest.

The greatest recognition of the voice of our Savior is found in his command of love. John 13:34-35 reads, "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." What makes this commandment new?

- We are to love everyone friends and enemies alike.
- Love is without exception our love is to extend to everyone.
- People will recognize us as followers of Jesus in our love of everyone.

Yet, what sets the command to love apart is we are to love as Jesus loved. Think for a moment about what I just said. How did Jesus love? He loved everyone. Friends and foes alike. His love was ultimately defined by one act. His love entailed death. He was willing to die for everyone. We call it sacrificial love. Our love is to be found in the same sacrificial love. It isn't ego driven; it is driven by a spirit of putting others before ourselves. For such a spirit, let us keep each other in prayer.

Starting Out on the Right Foot

Near a church in Kansas, there can be seen in a cement sidewalk the prints of two baby feet with the toes pointing toward the church. It was said that twenty years ago, when the sidewalk was being laid, a mother secured permission to stand her baby on the wet cement. The tracks are clearly seen today. 
