WEEKLY WORDS FROM THE ROCK:

Up, Up and Away...NO!

Today marks the Feast of the Ascension. At the end of his earthly life and work, Jesus ascends and takes his seat at the right hand of the Father in heaven. This feast has an upward trajectory.

I've mentioned to you before that I am not the luckiest of people. When I was in elementary school, we were asked to construct a kite. Once constructed, it would be taken outside and flown into the "heavenly realms." My kite was constructed in the same fashion as the others in class. I painted my kite blue with an image of a mallard duck on it and named it "The Flying Duck." It was finally the day, a beautiful sunny day. Some of the classmates already had their kites flying into the air and now it was my turn. I started to run in the direction of the wind, and my kite began its upward trajectory when all of a sudden it happened. My kite came crashing to the ground. I couldn't believe it. "The Flying Duck" was now a dead duck.

In high school, I had the opportunity to right myself. In science class, we were to build a rocket. I don't remember having to paint the rocket or name the rocket. Again, like the kite, I followed the directions, and my rocket looked no different from any other rockets constructed by my classmates. It was finally the day, another beautiful sunny day. Some of the rockets launched and went upward towards the heavenly realms. It was finally my turn. My rocket launched then hit a snag. Instead of going upward, it went more at a 45-degree angle. When it landed, it ended up in someone's backyard. That was the walk of shame. Instead of the rocket landing near to where it was launched, my rocket ended up a quarter of a mile away.

And that was the end of my kite and rocket days. I never tried again.

However, in the story of Jesus' ascension, upwards he ascends. As he ascends, the disciples look upwards remaining stationary for a time. They wonder, "What next? Is Jesus returning?" They are told that Jesus will return, not now, rather when he comes in all his glory. In the meantime, their work isn't focused on the upward but the outward. With the coming of the Holy Spirit, they are to go into the world and preach Jesus Christ.

Our work is the same. Our work isn't upward rather outward. With the Holy Spirit, we go and proclaim that Jesus Christ has died, has risen, and will come again at the end of the age in all his glory.


